
Churchyard Maintenance Saturday 18th May 9.30-11.30am

From the Rector

"Sticks and stones can break my bones, but words can never hurt me."

This phrase first appeared in 'The Christian Recorder', a publication of the African Methodist Episcopal Church on March 22nd 1862.

I wonder how many of you reading this letter remember those words. They were words that I chanted many times when I was a child. Words that my parents passed on to me and reminded me of if ever anyone was saying nasty or untrue words to me or about me. It was a phrase that was meant to make me feel better about myself if I was being hurt or provoked in any way. A phrase that could be chanted to other children as a way of self-defence. I rarely, if ever, hear the phase said or referred to nowadays.

At the time, some sixty odd years ago, just saying the words seemed to help and bring comfort. I don't believe that the world of my childhood was as hard, difficult or caustic as the world is today. I suspect that I haven't heard the words said for so long because WORDS CAN AND DO HURT on many levels. They hurt on a deeper inner level that perhaps wasn't considered in years gone by.

It saddens me when I hear people gossiping untruths about others. When things get passed on from one person to another and with each passing on another embellishment added. It saddens me that people become excluded from groups because of gossip, unkind, untrue words. People get hurt, and I'm not just talking about

our children. We moan about our young people falling out with each other, about the hurtful words they say to and about others and



yet so often they model their words and actions on adults. If only each one of us took more time to consider the consequences and the effect that, what we say, has on others then perhaps, just perhaps, the world in which we live may be a better place.

I'm not advocating that we let people walk all over us, or that we are never upset or cross because of what we hear, but perhaps if we can step back, take time to think and approach whatever or whoever has upset us in a kinder way, showing respect, then we have done the greater thing. People are often disarmed when their angry words or gossip is met with a calm response. We need to nurture the good we see in others and reject the bad.

There is too much anger, selfishness, and bitterness in the world today. If we all stepped back and looked to find the best and not the worst in a situation, thought carefully before we spoke then we would each be playing our part in making the world a kinder, friendly place.

In Jesus' words 'Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives.'

BTCC RETURNS THIS MAY

Brands Hatch will host its first Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship (BTCC) of the season on 11/12 May, the traditional spring-time round on the Indy circuit.

The event will feature three races as leading current generation drivers including Ash Sutton, Tom Ingram and Jake Hill try to get an early march on their rivals. They will battle it out on a competitive grid of Fords, BMWs, Hyundais and more saloon machinery.

The full weekend programme includes Free Practice plus the new-for-2024 Quick Six Qualifying format. Competitors progress through a series of knockout sessions in an attempt to claim pole position on Saturday. Sunday will feature the three headline races with a full support programme too.

Megastar drivers, including global motorcycle icon Valentino Rossi, will lineup on a grid which has often featured former Grand Prix and Le Mans drivers. The cars are the real stars too, with entries from Mercedes-AMG, Lamborghini, BMW and more set to feature on a mouth-watering grid!

Two hour-long races will top the bill with driver changes and pit stops adding to the intrigue. There will be a full support race line-up too, plus an extensive off-track programme headlined by the Supercar Collective car show.

Circuit Manager, Mike Lally, said: "We are constantly looking to improve the circuit and keep it in the best condition possible for our on-track events. This next step in resurfacing the track, which is being undertaken by Thomas Bow City Asphalt, will help us continue to provide excellent opportunities for drivers and riders alike."


